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Select Entry Accelerated Learning Program (SEALP)

SEALP provides an enhanced curriculum that extends work in all areas, with an emphasis on problem solving. Suitable students will have academic skills above those of their age peer group. The program covers delivery of content at a pace which matches the learning needs of the students providing opportunities for study in greater depth. There is greater emphasis on higher order thinking (analysis, creativity and evaluation).

Places are available to students who may benefit from taking part in SEALP, commencing in their first year of secondary education by virtue of their capacity and aptitude for “faster learning”.

What is SEALP?

SEALP differs from the mainstream curriculum in that it provides for:

- * *A more challenging learning environment with a faster paced curriculum which is not repetitive;*
- * *In depth coverage of essential learning;*
- * *An opportunity to work with more complex and more abstract course material;*
- * *Further enrichment for students with high level skills in particular academic fields;*
- * *An opportunity to work co-operatively with peers of similar ability.*

How does SEALP work?

SEALP students are accelerated through the Middle School Vertical Curriculum program, providing the opportunity to complete additional units in their preferred discipline and/or gain early access to VCE subjects. These additional subjects will increase student tertiary ranking and provide advantage in gaining admission into University and other Tertiary providers.

SEALP placements are awarded on achievement in the ACER External Examination and an interview with the Middle School Principal, Mr Anthony Jones.

How to apply

The application form is included in this booklet and contains all the details needed to apply for SEALP at Brauer College.

1. Fill in the application form/s contained in this booklet (see pages 5 - 8).
2. Include your references and any supporting documentation.

Who is eligible?

SEALP is available to students currently in Grade 6 or students entering the College at other levels. Students from government and non-government schools are encouraged to apply.

Criteria

Candidates are required to complete the SEALP application form and provide relevant references e.g. from primary school principals and/or teachers (applicable to Grade 6 only) to attest to their character and worthiness for consideration. Applicants may attach additional supporting documentation.

The selection process for this SEALP will be based on the student’s application, ACER testing, nominated referees and interview.

Closing date

SEALP applications for Grade 6 students are due on or before the 30th of May.

Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarships are awarded on achievement in the ACER (Australian Council for Educational Research) External Examination, endorsement from primary school of high range academic results and an interview with the Middle School Principal.

The College uses the ACER Scholarship Tests which consist of a series of academic ability tests requiring students to demonstrate a range of skills such as the ability to interpret, infer, deduce and think critically. They are not curriculum based and do not test the ability to retrieve learned knowledge.

Successful Academic Scholarship applicants will also be offered the opportunity to be part of the SEALP (Select Entry and Accelerated Learning Program) at Brauer College.

Community & Endeavour Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded to students who have shown a positive commitment to their learning, school and wider community.

Applicants will have demonstrated an involvement in co-curricular and community programs as well as a strong commitment to learning.

Leadership & General Excellence Scholarship

Leadership & General Excellence Scholarships are available for students eligible for entry from **Years 7-9**.

Students need to demonstrate:

- Achievement in several different fields in and out of school.
- Have undertaken leadership roles in previous school.

Public Speaking & Debating Scholarship

Brauer College offers a Public Speaking & Debating Scholarship to enrolling **Year 7** students, tenable for the period of enrolment at the college.

The scholarship is offered to students who have demonstrated ability in Public Speaking and who possess a keen interest in developing these skills further as members of the college's Public Speaking and Debating team at regional, state and national events.

Who is eligible?

Criteria

Candidates are required to complete the scholarship application form and provide relevant references e.g. from primary school principals, community leaders, service organisations or sports' clubs to attest to their character and worthiness for consideration. Applicants may attach additional supporting documentation e.g. community certificates or awards.

The selection process for scholarships will be based on the student's application, nominated referees and interview. The Year 7 Academic Scholarship is also based on ACER testing.

Closing date

Scholarship applications for Grade 6 students close of the 30th June.

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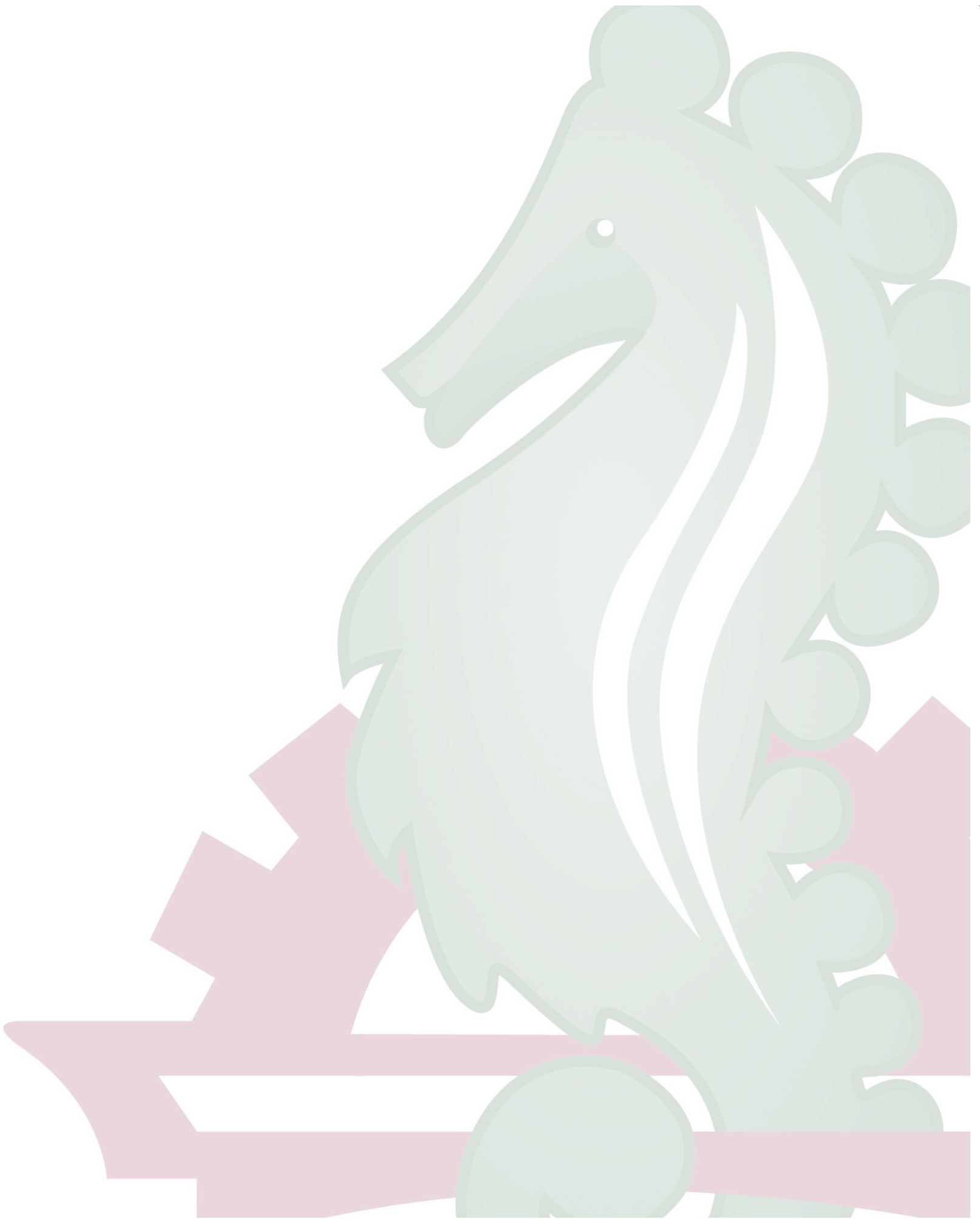
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
